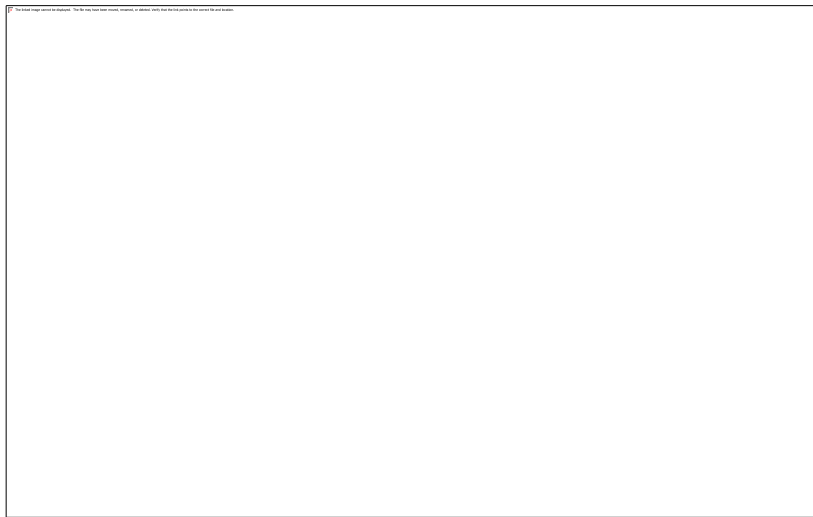


A New Partnership for DTU
