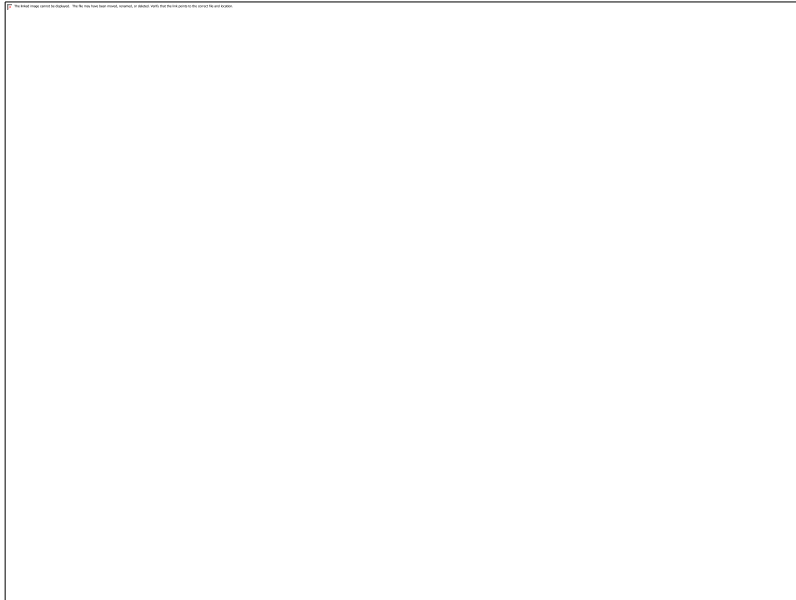


Book Review Presentation Contest at Duy Tan University

On April 12th 2009, the Social Sciences and Humanities Faculty collaborated with the Duy Tan library to hold the first round of a presentation contest called: “*Books Open a New Vision for Me*”, in the library.



The contest attracted eighty-two students from various faculties. As there were no restrictions on which titles could be presented, students reviewed a variety of their favorite literature, including children’s books, Vietnamese books, foreign books and so on.
