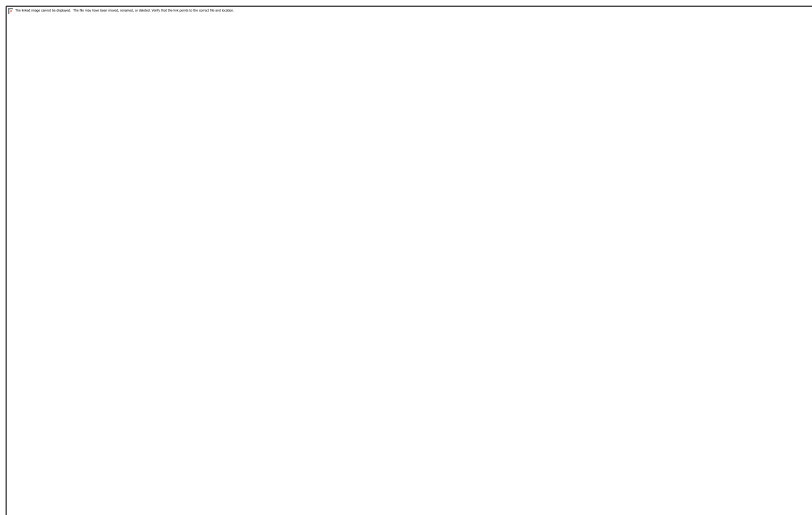


## Exchange of Ideas with Expert Nurse from USA

On August 4<sup>th</sup>, 2010, the Department of Medicine and Pharmacy held a conference entitled “Updating the Modern Trend in Structure and Organization of US and World’s Nursing Science, the Art of Nursing and its position in the Health Care System”



Participants included Dr. Janet Quillian, Seattle University’s Director of Cooperation and International Development, over thirty nurses from the Danang Polyclinic, Hospital 17, Hospital 199, other faculty members of Danang Medical Centers and Professors, Doctors of the new DTU Department of Medicine and Pharmacy.
