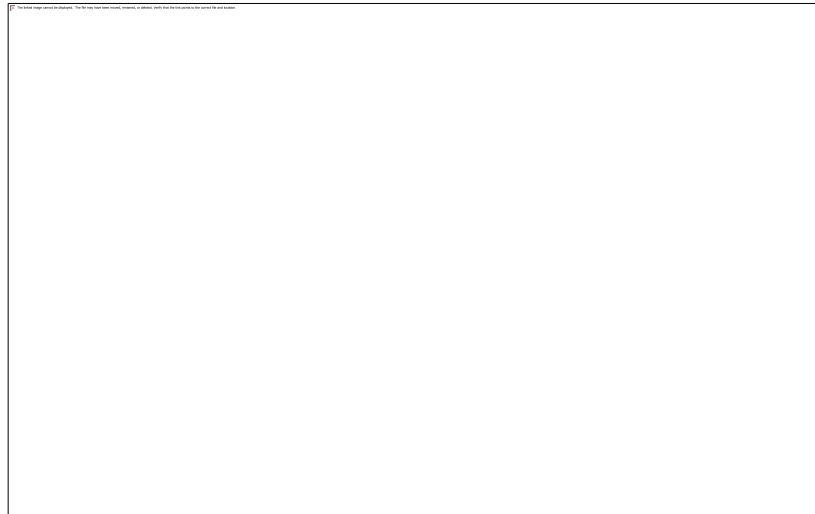


## Professor Phong Le Talks About Uncle Ho
