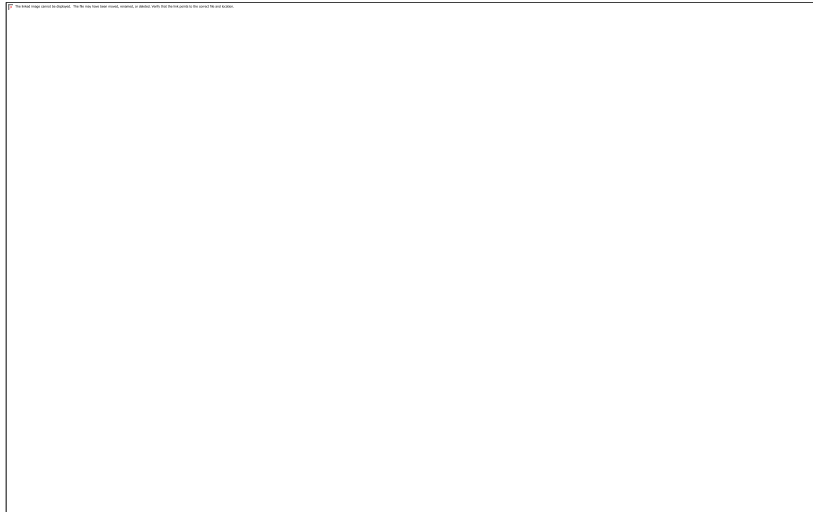


The DTU Department of Medical Care Holds a Seminar on Vietnamese Teachers' Day
